Pre Questions

- 1. Jesus refers to the Holy Spirit as the Helper, whom the Father will send in His name. How does understanding the Holy Spirit as our Helper influence your daily walk with Christ?
- 2. In what ways have you experienced the Holy Spirit teaching you or bringing to remembrance the words of Jesus in your life?

QUESTIONS

- 1. Jesus promises peace through the Holy Spirit, not as the world gives. How does this peace differ from worldly peace, and how have you experienced it?
- 2. What are some misconceptions people might have about the Holy Spirit, and how can we address them with biblical truth?

READ JOHN 16:7-13

- 3. Jesus says it is for our good that He goes away so the Helper can come. How does this passage deepen your understanding of the Holy Spirit's role in guiding us into truth?
- 4. What are some ways you can practice listening more attentively to the Spirit's leading in your daily life?

READ ROMANS 8:26-27

- 5. Paul writes that the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness and intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. How does knowing that the Spirit prays for you change the way you view prayer and dependence on God?
- 6. When have you experienced the Spirit's help when you didn't know how to pray?

Application Questions

- 7. Identify areas in your life where you need the guidance and comfort of the Holy Spirit. How can you invite Him into these situations?
- 8. How can our church community become more aware of and responsive to the leading of the Holy Spirit in our gatherings and ministries?
- 9. What practical steps can you take this week to cultivate a deeper relationship with the Holy Spirit, recognizing Him as the third person of the Trinity?
