

Pro-life or just pro-birth....which ones are Christians...really?

Psalm 139:1-16

MAIN POINT

God cares for you because God created you.

On your own: use these questions to prepare for your group discussion (optional)

1. What questions do you still have about the passage?
2. What are the main points, ideas, and themes in the passage?
3. What did you learn about God from this passage?
4. What did you learn about humanity from this passage?
5. How does this passage apply to your life right now?
6. What are one or two concrete ways you can live out this truth this week?

PRE-DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

With your group: discuss the following questions:

1. Where have you experienced God's "ferocious love"? In other words, how have you felt the love of your Heavenly Father in both the big and little moments of your life?
2. What do verses 1-6 tell us about God? What does God know about us?
3. What are some of the advantages of God knowing everything about you? How could this be a source of motivation in your life?
4. How often do you stop to consider that God has been interested in you even before you were born, and so he is intensely interested in the outcome of your life? How should knowing this shape your behavior and decisions?
5. Have you or someone you know ever wondered if your life has any value?
6. There is a lot of buzz around abortion in Michigan, Roe V. Wade, etc. What have you heard? What questions do you have? (option: submit these questions by texting 97000 with "goodquestion")
7. If someone came up to you right now and stated that they think Christians are only pro-birth, how would you respond? What tone of voice would you use?
