Proclaim for the health of the Church

Colossians 1:3-8

MAIN POINT

We won't be effective in our mission if our church isn't healthy.

On your own: use these questions to prepare for your group discussion (optional)

1. What questions do you still have about the passage?
2. What are the main points, ideas, and themes in the passage?
3. What did you learn about God from this passage?
4. What did you learn about humanity from this passage?
5. How does this passage apply to your life right now?
6. What are one or two concrete ways you can live out this truth this week?

GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

With your group: discuss the following questions:

1. Read Galatians 6:10 together. Who are we especially meant to do good towards? Why is this often neglected?
2. How does the gospel motivate our love for each other?
3. The challenge for this week: "Do we give in a way that keeps our church healthy?" What do you think that means?
4. Take an extended time to pray for one another, asking God to unify you as a group and as brothers and sisters in Christ.

Proclaim Week 1 Sermon Notes

1. Before we pray for the world, we must pray for each other (v3)
 - Verse 3 makes it clear that Paul REGULARLY prays for the church in Colossai.
2. Before we love the world, we must love each other (v4-5)
 - The gospel is our motivating factor for loving each other.
3. Before we share the gospel, we must adhere to the gospel (v6-8)
 - The gospel must bear fruit in our life in order for it to be attractive to those outside the church.
